

PUBLICATION NORMS:

- Students who have participated at Mostratec or Mostratec Júnior will be able to submit their texts for publication.
- The texts must be authentic and unpublished.
- The objective of Liberato Científica is to disseminate science to a broad public, not only to scientists. Therefore, the language used has to be different from that used in research reports or in scientific articles published in more specialized periodicals. Plenty of scientists are readers of Liberato Científica, but, as the publication aims at reaching out people who are not experts, the text needs to be simple and clear.
- The photos and images must be in separate documents, preferably in .tif. ou .eps files (300 dpi resolution) and have to be identified. Graphs and other figures must be sent in the edition original format and, if it is not possible, the files have to be sent in .jpg format and with the best resolution possible.
- The texts must be typed in any editing software using A4 size, Arial 12 font, line spacing of 1.5, top and left margins of 3cm, bottom and right margins of 2cm. The texts must be from one to three pages long.
- Scientific papers will be accepted once they include the following fundamental points about the research project: who did the research, what institution the authors belong to, what they found out (even if the results are partial), when they performed the research, why they chose the theme (justification of the study), the methodology used. The authors may defend, in this text, a point of view related to their research, stating opinions about the topic chosen. The arguments must be based on scientific data. The following steps of the research may be mentioned, as well as the fairs in which the project has been or will be presented. The article must have a creative title and subtitle sentence so that the reader feels motivated to read the full text. Besides photos, figures, graphs, info graphics, outlines, other elements may be included. We recommend labeling the visual elements with descriptive captions.
- Note: In a paragraph apart from the body of the text, the authors must answer the following
 question: What was the importance of developing this research project and taking part in fairs
 with it? They also need to write a brief timeline of the project development with the main
 steps taken until the publication of the article.



Exemple:

Project timeline:

February 2019: choice of the theme and mentor.

Março de 2019: design of the research project.

April to July 2019: data gathering and analysis.

August 2019: participation and awards at __(fair)

August 2019: participation and awards at ...(fair). September 2019: participation and awards at ...(fair).

October 2019: participation and awards at Mostratec/Mostratec Júnior.

March 2020: participation at ... (fair), following the credentials received at Mostratec.

- The texts can be written in English, Portuguese or Spanish...
- All the texts will be evaluated by the Publishing Committee of Liberato Científica, taking into
 account the adequacy to the norms and to the language aimed at non-expert readers. The
 texts can be declined or sent back to the authors for them to make necessary changes.
- The texts can be subjected to changes due to linguistic revisions or to adequacy to the
 objectives of the publication. The final version is submitted to the authors so that they can
 endorse the changes.
- The authors must present, together with the project, their full names, the mentor's name, addresses, phone numbers, e-mails, photo and identification of the school they go to.
- The texts must be sent to the Fundação Liberato through the following e-mail: divugacao.cientifica@liberato.com.br.

Summarizing...

Check if your text meets all the publication requirements:

- 1. Did it answer the following questions?
 - a. Who did the research?
 - b. What institution do the authors belong to?
 - c. What did the researchers find out? (even if the results are partial)?
 - d. When did the authors perform the research?
 - e. Why did the authors research about this theme (justification of the study)?
 - f. What was the methodology used?
- 2. Does the text have a title and a subtitle?
- 3. Does the text have from one to three pages in A4 size?
- 4. Does the text present a paragraph apart from the body of the text answering the following question 'What was the importance of developing this research and taking part in fairs with it?'?
- 5. Does the text present the required timeline?
- 6. Does the text present language that meets the requirements established by *Liberato Científica*?
